## Stoneflies: Stimulator / Kaufman's Stone Stonefly Creeper / Montana Nymph



### Stimulator

Hook	12-16 Daiichi 1270
Thread	hot orange
Abdomen	yellow antron
Rib	brown hackle
Downwing	elk hair
Thorax	amber antron
Hackle	grizzly hackle
Tail	elk hair
Originator	Randall Kaufmann, Washington
Tyer	Ed Ostapczuk



### Kaufmann's Stonefly Nymph (yellow/gold)

Hook	#6 or 8 Mustad 9575
Thread	Tan
Weight	Lead wire, flattened
Tail	Goose biots, color to match body color
Rib	Dark brown dyed flat monofilament
Body	Amber Kaufmann Stonefly Blend Dubbing
Wingcase	Three sections of turkey tail, tied in three sections on top of the thorax, and clipped to a "v" on top
Thorax	Same as body
Antennae	Goose biots
Originator	Randall Kaufman, Oregon
Tyer	Tim Didas



### Stonefly Creeper

Hook	8 Mustad 9671
Thread	primrose
Abdomen	quill from light ginger hackle
Thorax	amber seal dub
Wing case	wood duck extending over entire body, tied in at both ends
Tail	two pheasant tail barbs, at least half-inch long
Legs	grouse
Thread	primrose
Originator	Art Flick, New York
Tyer	Tim Didas



### Montana Nymph

Hook	#6, 8 or 10 Mustad 9575, 9672, 79580
Thread	Black
Tail	Black hackle fibers
Weight	Lead wire or equivalent (optional)
Body	Black chenille
Wingcase	2 strands of black chenille
Thorax	Yellow chenille
Hackle	Black
Originator	unknown
Tyer	Tim Didas
